### Extended Abstracts for Oral and Poster Presentations

#### Length, Format, and Font

Extended abstracts, not exceeding 1000 words, and their short summaries (up to 200 words) should be prepared using the **provided template**. Abstracts should be in Calibri font, 11pt, single-spaced. All figures and tables should be placed within the text.

#### Versions for Extended Abstracts

Please submit **two versions** of your extended abstract:

##### Version 1

Version 1 should include a **cover page** with the names, affiliations, and contact details of all authors, three to six keywords, and JEL code, if available. The second page should contain the title and a short summary (200 words) of the manuscript. Extended abstracts have to include the following sections:

Page 1:	<b>Cover page</b>
Page 2:	<b>Title and summary of the extended abstract</b>
Page 3 and following:	<b>1 Problem background</b>
	<b>2 Research questions</b>
	<b>3 Data and methods</b>
	<b>4 (Preliminary) results</b>
	<b>5 References</b>

Please use the provided Word template and follow the specified structure.

File name: **first author\_website.pdf** (e.g., mueller\_website.pdf).

##### Version 2 (for double-blind review)

The second version follows the same structure but WITHOUT a cover page.–Please use the provided Word template and follow the specified structure. – **do not forget to remove the cover page and make sure that the file does not carry any personal information.**

File name: **first author\_review.pdf** (e.g., mueller\_review.pdf).

References are cited in the text by giving the name of the author and year of publication (Chicago Author-Date Referencing Style)
